FAPC is an officially recognized council charged with improving the well-being of our patients and medical center personnel by addressing the issue of family abuse in all of its forms.

Our group includes nursing, social work, employees, physicians, and administrators - from Stanford Hospital and Clinics, Lucile Packard Children's Hospital, and the Stanford School of Medicine.

Our goals are to:

- standardize and monitor legally required abuse screening of our patients
- improve student/personnel education and training in recognizing and responding to patients who have been abused
- provide safety and referral information for patients
- provide resources for employees and managers in supporting co-workers with home abuse difficulties
- stimulate medical-related research on the problem of abuse
- outreach to the medical and general community
